

**Myddle C. E. Primary School**  
**Class Two Curriculum Content - Spring Term 2007**

During this term our focus will be on History. We will be studying our local area, with the focus of our study being the school. We will look at how the buildings and features of Myddle have changed over the years. As a class we will be considering key questions like: What is our area like today? How can we use maps to explore how our area has changed? What can local buildings or sites tell us about the past? What do pictures and photographs tell us about past life in our area? What was it like to live in our area in the past?

In Art we will be carrying on the focus of looking at the village of Myddle. From photographs we will produce pictures, using a combination of mediums that show a journey through the village.

In Science we will be the characteristics of materials. We will look at solids and liquids and we will investigate ways in which they can be changed and separated.

In ICT we will be building up our basic skill using a computer and then using these skills to produce work in English, Maths, Science and our topic area of Myddle history. As part of our PSHE we will be looking at health and in RE we will look at Christian stories, special people and the story of Easter.

Finally in PE for the first half of the term we will have cricket / football every Tuesday and swimming every Wednesday. In the second half term we will focus on dance.

The children will continue to have daily Literacy and Numeracy lessons following the National Literacy and Numeracy programmes of study.
