# December/ January - It's your choice

The way we celebrate Christmas may be different this year, but we will celebrate. This has been happening for nigh on 2020 years because, thankfully, whatever we do, the Christmas story never changes; it lives on, it's history, His story, the story of Jesus' birth within the whole story of God.

At this time, we remember that God, our Almighty Creator, became a human being to show us something. Not just all those lessons from Jesus, such as how to behave towards each other, or that God's power can heal, or all about the wisdom of God.

This reminds us that Jesus came for everyone. Nobody is excluded from his love. Not only was his birth experience shocking and all-inclusive, but we know that it was just the beginning of God's message of love towards us, and leads us on to Easter, when Jesus died (again in awful circumstances) and rose again, to break any divisions left between God and us. So, we are given a choice. We can decide that the Christmas story is just history, or we can believe that Christmas is really His story and choose to have an ongoing relationship with Jesus.

# Shropshire is determined that Covid won't be the Grinch that steals Christmas

Carols on the Doorstep is set to unite the people of Shropshire and will take place on December 16, repeated on Christmas Eve, supported by BBC Radio Shropshire. Organisers are hoping the idea will catch on countrywide and raise money for a host of different charities. My Shrewsbury magazine has joined forces with Shropshire Festivals to organise the event. They are asking everyone to sing carols on their doorsteps to bring the county together in festive spirit.

BBC Radio Shropshire will broadcast a set list of carols and Christmas songs to help everyone keep in time – or streets can choose to organise their own live 'doorstep' music, all socially distanced of course.

#### Correspondence

The Clerk always forwards to Members relevant items of correspondence he receives to enable prompt responses to be made where necessary. Since the last meeting there had been over forty items and this did not include a range of messages about Coronavirus or Council road works around the County.

#### External Audit

The report, which indicated that no concerns had been raised by the auditors about the management of the Council and its finances, had been forwarded to Members and was adopted.

The Chairman thanked the Clerk for successfully seeing the Council through the audit.

#### Planning

A number of planning applications had been received, considered and responded to with no objections raised.

It was noted that there had been no appeal against the decision to refuse planning approval for the development at the Harmer Hill Reservoir. As a result the Clerk was asked to contact Shropshire Council's planning department and request that an enforcement order be issued to ensure that the owner of the land took action to remove the partial development from the site.

#### Shropshire Bus Project Report

In June 2019 the Shropshire Bus Project was launched with the aim of exploring ways in which bus services in Shropshire could be improved. Bus services have declined nationally in rural areas and a national organisation, the Foundation for Integrated Transport (FIT) was set up in 2014 to promote sustainable and transformational transport solutions. The Shropshire Project contacted Shropshire Council, town and parish councils and other organisations such as the Women's Institute to ask for comments and suggestions for improvements. Myddle, Broughton and Harmer Hill Parish residents sent in suggestions and these were passed on to the Project.

In 2020 six key recommendations were made to Shropshire Council.

#### They were:

Increase the bus support budget from £2.8 million in 2018-19 to £6.39 million in 2021-22.
Increase the diversity of operators and consider alternative ways of providing bus services.

providing bus services. Invite bids from town and parish councils for specific improvements to bus services. This should include a commitment to county-wide timetables (printed and online). Adopt the "single ticket" model which would cover every trip and every operator across the county as a whole. Build a new bus station in Shrewsbury and improve the Park & Ride services in Shrewsbury and Ludlow. Shropshire Council should jointly fund (with the NHS) a fully electric bus, free to use from Shrewsbury Bus Station to the Royal Shrewsbury Hospital (RSH). The RSH is the largest car trip generator in Shropshire and reducing car journeys would reduce congestion and air pollution in Shrewsbury as well as the need to build a £5 million multi-storey car park at RSH.

Some specific bus service improvements were costed but none of these related directly to this parish.

#### They were:

- The Meole Brace P&R service extended to Bayston Hill A bus- train connection linking Bishop's Castle to Craven Arms Reinstate the 141 Ludlow to Bridgnorth via Ditton Priors A direct service from Craven Arms to Princess Royal Hospital or a direct service from West Felton to RSH
- Connect Ellesmere with Wrexham and Whitchurch via a service from Overton.

#### Highways Issues

There was no reports of any action having been taken to deal with the issues raised at the last meeting and Members have become so angry about the lack of action that it was agreed that the Clerk should compile a list of all the issues that have been forwarded to Shropshire Council over the past four to five years, which had still not been actioned. When approved by the Chairman, the details would be sent to the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer at Shropshire Council.

#### Play Areas

Members were advised of the receipt of the RoSPA report on both Play Areas indicating a few relatively minor problems which were being dealt with plans to re-paint the shelter on the Myddle site next spring.

#### Bus Service Review

Councillor Ms. J. Bienek gave a report on the findings arising from the recent survey of bus services in Shropshire, which had been undertaken in an effort to improve the service for the public, especially those living in rural areas.

A number of recommendations had been made, the main one being that Shropshire Council should increase its budget for bus services to £6.39 million from the current level of £2.8.million.

Other recommendations included diversification of operators; single ticket fares; improved park and ride facilities; a new bus station for Shrewsbury and a regular 10

minute electric bus service from central Shrewsbury to the hospital.

In the current financial crisis is seems unlikely that these recommendations will become a reality in the near future.

#### PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

#### Council Meeting

Covid restrictions continue to prevent the Council holding meetings in the Village Halls as was the normal practice. Members are frustrated and disappointed by this and realise that it makes it difficult for local residents to meet with them and raise issues of concern or comment on Council activity. However you are reminded that you can speak to your local Councillors; contact the Parish Clerk who is happy to give you advice or where necessary bring it to the attention of all the Members or gain computer access to the meetings by asking the Chairman for the necessary code. Modern technology is a wonderful asset – sometimes! The latest Council meeting was held on November 4<sup>th</sup> and one person who took advantage of accessing the meeting was Karyn Row from Harmer Hill. Karyn has recently set up a splendid Neighbourhood Watch scheme in Harmer Hill and was keen to secure Council support to develop a local Smart Water project, which is organised by the police. She gave an interesting presentation and supported it with a range of documents. Members have agreed to discuss it in detail at the January meeting and if you are interested have any comments please get in touch. In the meeting which followed Members considered and discussed a full range of issues including:

#### Street Lights

It was noted that all the lights owned by the Council had been converted to Led lighting units which reduces the use of electricity and maintenance costs. The invoice for the work had been settled and the money came from the Community Infrastructure Levy which is charged on new housing development. As a result there was no cost on your local rates.

I carefully lifted the cardboard box from under the altar where it had been since last January. Placing it on the floor between the choir stalls I sat beside it. Gently I unwrapped each tissue parcel revealing the delicate porcelain figures. Shepherds, a donkey, Mary, Joseph, a beautiful angel with arched white wings and a boy carrying a lamb.

Oh! There you are; a pink skinned, blue eyed Baby Jesus with golden curls smiled back at me from the palm of my hand. Later that afternoon, during the crib service a much smaller pair of hands would carefully place Him in the manger. Whilst a group of enraptured children, heads draped in tea towels or adorned with tinsel halos would look on at the candle lit scene unfolding before them.

The familiar strains of Away in a Manger would ring out once again while proud parents and grandparents gazed on, bathed in nostalgia. Later we would hand out gingerbread and chocolate. Enveloped in the warm glow of Christ's coming families file out of church; "Have a happy Christmas", "Have a Good one!" they shout. Those of us remaining sweep up the bits of hay dropped along the aisle, leaving the church tidy for midnight mass.

In twelve days' time we would be wrapping Jesus in tissue paper again and placing Him in the box that will stay under the altar for another year. A man looks down from the wooden cross above the pulpit. How easy it is to lose our way between Bethlehem and Calvary.

Did you know that £6 in 1993 had a purchasing power at the time that is equivalent to £12.30 today? The St Peter's Church 100+ Club began in 1993 with a ticket price of £6 and so it is clearly time to review the ticket price and of course the value of prizes.

Having considered the arrangements for what is now known as the 100+ Club the Parochial Church Council has decided to raise the ticket price for 2021 to £10 (an increase of 67%). For the quarterly draws

The 1st prize will be £50 (double the current prize of £25) The 2nd prize will be £20 (a 33% increase on the current prize of £15) The 3rd prize will be £15 (a 50% increase on the current prize of £10)

A bonus prize of £35 will be added for the Christmas draw for each additional 10 tickets that are sold above 100.
