A Family History Project

The observation that nothing can be certain except for death and taxes often attributed to is Benjamin Franklin in 1789 although the thought had been committed to paper some 70 years earlier by Christopher Bullock in the Cobbler of Preston. The universality of death means that graveyards are a rich source of information for family historians. About 40 years ago a group came together to record the memorial inscriptions to be found in the churchyard at St Peter's. 40 years ago personal computers were a rare luxury.

So their work was recorded using a typewriter and has not been updated. It is planned to review this work and to consider how it might be extended, updated and made more accessible to family historians.

I have a magnet on the door of my fridge which bears the message "Prayer changes things". I keep it there to remind me of what I often forget. Not only do I forget that taking any kind of action changes things, but I also forget that praying about anything and everything is actually taking action.

When problems occur as they frequently do, prayer is the only way I know to contract the highest of high powers and to seek for help. That higher power has an overview of the world and of my life in relation to that world. He is generally known as "God", but I think of Him as my Father in heaven.

When my own father died at an early age, I was angry with God for taking him from me. As a fairly new Christian at the time, I was also aware that Jesus thought of God as the best possible kind of father and that as a follower of Jesus, I should do the same. Fortunately, my human father and I had had a good relationship and I had been able to share all my thoughts and feelings with him, so began to do the same with God. I began a prayerful conversation with God and in time He did become my heavenly Father.

Jesus tells us that God is like a loving father who only wants the best for His children so in times of hardship, need or any kind of trouble, the first thing we should think of doing is contacting God, our heavenly Father who is always ready to help us. Being human we usually try everything and everyone else first and only come to God as a last resort. Hence, the need for reminders like my fridge magnet.

This time, we think that what has happened is such that He cannot possibly help us. So, we delay taking prayerful action and even attempt to convince ourselves that there is no way God could answer us. Yet, all prayers are answered if we know how to look for the answers and iust as importantly, we are prepared for an answer we do not want. Also, it is important at a time like this to let God, be God as we remember that He has an overview of everything, so he knows what is best for us, usually when we do not. When we pray, we need to be prepared for God to answer in His time and in His way. He may answer us in a positive way when we can clearly see what is happening through the circumstances around us. He may answer us through the words He prompts other people to speak. A negative response that stops us in our tracks can be given in this way too. The hardest answer to a prayer is "wait".

Whatever the answer is going to be, God, the creator and sustainer of the universe will find a way of revealing it to us if only we stay alert and keep looking for it. Something else that prevents us going to God sooner rather than later is that we are not sure how to begin praying. Even Jesus' disciples had trouble with this one, but Jesus offered them a solution in what we now call "The Lord's Prayer". Generations learned this prayer at school or at Sunday School and often chanted it without thought or any real understanding. Many people know of it but have never learned it which is a great pity because it is one of the best, if not the best way to begin a prayerful conversation with God.

Below is a copy of The Lord's Prayer with particular thoughts and explanations of each line for those who might need to refresh their memories, those who have never come across them before and anyone who wants to begin a thoughtful conversation with God and needs a place to begin. Prayer changes things! It constantly brings change to my life (when I remember to go to God first) and always for the better. A relationship with the highest of high powers is waiting for each one of us and is literally only a prayer away.
