



with Shropshire Council the possibility of joining their consortium which had been offered a much lower rate for power supply.

# Middle Playing Field & Adjacent Woodland:

As part of their lease with Shropshire Council for this area the Council are tasked with the overall maintenance of the woodland and having received reports about its current state it was agreed to get Mr. Terry Merchant to carry out a full safety inspection and then deal with any issues arising from the inspection. Once this had been completed, Members would seek volunteer help to deal with the undergrowth. In her role as Tree Officer Councillor J. Jackson would join Mr. Merchant during the inspection.

### Allotments:

Councillor K. Roe reported that due to pressure of work she was unable to carry on dealing with the many issues that were required in setting up an Allotment Association. A number of people were interested in the concept but to date no-one had offered to take over responsibility but she sincerely hoped that someone would find

sufficient time to deal with it.

### **Planning Applications:**

Since the last Council meeting three applications had been received and considered by Members with no concerns raised and it was noted that Shropshire Council had approved all three of them.

### The Annual Parish Meeting:

Members confirmed the agenda for the Annual Parish Meeting which is being held in Harmer Hill Village Hall on Wednesday May 18<sup>th</sup>. This is an open meeting and gives residents the chance to meet up with Councillors, exchange information and raise issues of concern. Everyone is welcome to attend.

# Parish Council News

The Council AGM was held in Myddle Village Hall on Wednesday May 4th. when Councillor Colin Ruck was unanimously re-elected as Chairman for the coming year Councillor and Marshal Andrew elected as Vice Chairman, following the resignation of Councillor Ian Anderson, Various Members agreed to take responsibility for a range of Council activities.

Before the election of officers. Members had confirmed the co-option of Mr. Andrew Jones from Lower Road. Harmer Hill who was replacing Mrs. Helen Morgan who had resigned following her election as the local MP. In the business which followed Members considered wide ranging issues including:

### **Queens Jubilee:**

Members were informed that committees in Harmer Hill and Myddle were both planning various activities to celebrate the Jubilee and it was agreed to provide a grant of £250.00 to each Jubilee Committee, providing a written request was received by the Clerk outlining the

need for financial support. It was also agreed to purchase two seats for erection near the Village Hall in Myddle and possibly on the Playing Field in Harmer Hill and the Council's Jubilee Committee were tasked with refining the details.

### **Grants:**

part of the Council's acknowledgement of the valued service provided by the Village Halls and the local Churches, a grant of £2,000.00 was given to each Village Hall and £500.00 towards the maintenance of the grounds at Myddle and Broughton Churches. A grant of £500.00 was given to defray the cost of printing the Messenger which provides a very valuable source of community information. Members were advised the Youth Club was re-opening in Myddle Village Hall and a grant of £500.00 was given to help the re-establishment of the activities.

### Street Lights

### June 2022 - Pastoral Letter

It is amazing what a little bit of sunshine can do. It makes the flowers grow and bathes everything in golden sunlight and somehow our hearts are lifted. We can sit in the garden and eat and socialize; we can spend more time outside with longer daylight hours.

This is good for us as we become closer to nature. We exercise more and make Vitamin D. This is all good for our well-being, both physically and mentally. There is something I find fascinating about people who are happy to be in their own skin and seem to be fully alive and enjoying life.

#### New online coaching service in Shropshire for people who struggle with reading

It's taken for granted that we all learned to read and write at school, however there are many local people who struggle with this essential life skill. Just imagine how your life would be if you couldn't read forms or letters, follow medicine instructions, or read a new recipe?

#### Free, confidential, one-to-one help

Read Easy Shropshire Hills matches up adults who want to learn to read with a trained reading coach and they work together through reading manuals, in private, at a time to suit them both. It's as easy as that and its free!

What's important is that everyone can learn at their own pace without feeling rushed. There's no pressure or targets or exams to worry about and no reminders of what it was like at school.

Before the pandemic all coaching sessions were held face-to-face in quiet locations such as cafes and libraries, but out of necessity we have had to find new ways to keep on coaching. Coaching online or via WhatsApp has been so successful and convenient for many reading pairs that, by working with other Read Easy groups, we can now offer the service to anyone in Shropshire during the day or after work.

It doesn't matter if a new reader doesn't have access to a computer or has never used one before. We can loan readers a tablet, set it up for them, and show them how to use it even if they have no computer or keyboard skills. However, online coaching isn't for everyone and for some of our readers coaching by phone is a better option.

We will continue to offer face-to-face coaching to people who would prefer to meet in person if there is a suitable local venue.
