Memories from Times Past

All five farm brothers plagued

COINCIDENCE

The youngest of the brothers, 43year-old Mr. Herbert Griffiths, of Higher Kempley Farm, Willaston, Calverhall, can only call it a tragic coincidence because their farms are scattered all over North Shropshire.

Many farms around them have emerged from the epidemic with stock intact but the disease seems to have almost singled out the Griffiths brothers

They carried out intense precautions against infection, banning visits from everyone including each other

Mr. Frank Griffiths (50), of Burlton Grange, Burlton, near Shrewsbury, was the first to suffer. He had to have his 160 sheep, 160 cattle and 30 pigs slaughtered.

Then the eldest, 65-year-old Mr. Tommy Griffiths, of Lower Holston, Myddle, became a victim, losing 125 cattle.

It was never as bad for the farming Cartwright brothers on their Ponderosa ranch...there was always one of them left to save the day.

Not so for the farming Griffiths brothers of Shropshire. First one, then two, three, four and finally five of them became victims of foot and mouth disease. They have lost nearly 1,000 stock.

And as if to prove that 1967 really was awoman's year—remember Twiggy and Barbara Castle—their two farming sisters have escaped unscathed.

Now more than 1,100 acres owned by the brothers — Herbert, Ernest, George, Frank and Tom, — are empty and deserted.

MISFORTUNE

Forty-eight year-old Mr. George Griffiths soon shared their misfortune at Haughton Farm, West Felton, near Oswestry. His 148-strong herd was infected.

Back at Myddle, 45-year-old Mr. Ernest Griffiths, of Houlston Manor, was struck, losing 187 cattle.

Finally, Mr. Herbert Griffiths lost
his 150 cows athis Calverhall Farm.

Sisters Mrs. Leslie Downes, of Astley Grange, near Shrewsbury, and Mrs. H. Humphries of Kinlet, Bridgnorth, both married to farmers, are so far safe. And three other brothers are presumably thankful they did not become farmers.

"But we have every intention of going on farming," said Mr. Herbert Griffiths. "It has just been very bad luck."

PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

The latest online Council meeting was held on January 6th, when a range of issues were considered, including:

The Council Budget for 2021 – 2022

Members had been forwarded a copy of proposed budget which had been prepared by the Clerk and already discussed with the Chairman and Vice Chairman. Following consideration of some items and an agreed recommendation that the grant to each Village Hall should be increased to £2,000, the budget was approved.

In spite of anticipated inflationary increases it was unanimously agreed not to seek an increase in the precept which could have resulted in an increase in the Community Tax. Full details of the budget can be found on the Councils website.

Highways

It was noted that following letters of complaint to Shropshire Council's Leader and C.E.O about the lack of action over reported problems, there had been positive responses to some of the issues that had been raised, although there were still a few outstanding. It had been hoped that these would have been resolved following the break for Christmas and the New Year but with the new 'lock down' regulations it was felt that there would be a further delay.

The Clerk reported that the need for the construction of a footpath alongside the old Red Castle car park had been added to the Parish Place Plan but there were difficulties in securing CIL (Local) funding for the Project. It was agreed that the Clerk should write to the CEO again, thanking him for his actions but pointing out the difficulty in getting responses for certain officers who may well be working from home or furloughed.

Correspondence

Over seventy items of correspondence from a variety of sources had been received by the Clerk and passed to Members since the previous meeting. These were considered and where necessary replies had been made or were approved at the meeting.


