September 2021 - Love in a Box

Last Autumn our parishes sent over 130 shoe boxes filled with gifts to needy children and families in Romania via the charity Teams4U. Charity founder. Dave Cooke. recently delivered a new supply of flatpack boxes here and told of giving boxes to children who had never even seen a box before and were absolutely amazed to discover all sorts of lovely treasures inside.

Although it's only September, thanks to beautiful donations from knitters plus clever from outgrown toys schoolchildren. Mvddle some shoe boxes have been packed here already this year. It would be great if we could raise our total and send more boxes to children who get no other Christmas presents.

Anyone can be part of this project to bring colour and joy into the lives of some of the poorest of the poor. Just save an empty shoe box, cover it in colourful paper (or collect a flatpack box from the Rectory, Mvddle) choose an age category (boy or girl, 3-5, 6-11 or 12+ years) and fill the box with gifts, simple things we take for granted like soap & flannel, toothbrush & paste, paper & pens, warm hat, scarf & gloves, and small toys.

The Teams4U website www.teams4u.com gives all information and short videos with ideas of how to pack a child's box for each of the six age categories, or a home box for a family. Age labels to stick on the box can he downloaded or cut from one of the charity leaflets, available here at the Rectory.

A Family History Project

The observation that nothing can be certain except for death and taxes often attributed to is Benjamin Franklin in 1789 although the thought had been committed to paper some 70 years earlier by Christopher Bullock in the Cobbler of Preston. The universality of death means that graveyards are a rich source of information for family historians. About 40 years ago a group came together to record the memorial inscriptions to be found in the churchyard at St Peter's. 40 years ago personal computers were a rare luxury.

So their work was recorded using a typewriter and has not been updated. It is planned to review this work and to consider how it might be extended, updated and made more accessible to family historians.




