#### Did you know you can grow avocados at home?



Remove the stone & peel the brown skin from it. Next, with the pointy end facing upwards, you can insert 3 cocktail sticks into it & use these to rest it on a glass. Fill the glass with water, so that it reaches halfway up the stone. Now, leave it in a sunny window & wait, ensuring you refresh the water often & remove any algae that grows. In a few weeks the stone will crack & a root (or roots!) will grow out of the bottom & eventually the plant will grow out of the top. Once the plant roots out - grow the glass, pot the plant in compost & water frequently.

I was then employed as PA to the Chief Executive of Shropshire Health Authority and the Chairman of SHA. During this time I took an Open University degree in Health & Social science. It was a very busy time with looking after the family and a full time job. I am pleased to say I did come out after 3 years with a Second Degree.

Whilst I have been in Myddle I have been a councillor on the Parish Council for many years, I was on the committee which set up the Myddle Playground, was a committee member on the Village Hall and I have been very involved with St.Peter's Church, as a PCC member, Editor for the Messenger, and Secretary to the Deanery Synod.

### PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

Council Meeting

The September meeting was again held online using Zoom, when a range of issues were discussed. It had been hoped that the November meeting could take place in Harmer Hill Village Hall and plans were discussed about holding the Annual Parish meeting on the same date. Unfortunately new Government regulations issued later in the week meant that neither of these events could take place as planned.

Issues discussed included:

Mid-Year Financial Statement

The report was prepared and presented by the Clerk, indicating that the Council were keeping well within the planned expenditure budget. The full report can be found on the Council web site or can be obtained by post from the Clerk. It was pleasing to hear that Shropshire Council had again made a grant of £1,500, which meant that the Community Environment Project was safe for another year.

Unwelcome Traffic

Concern was expressed by several Members about the size and length of vehicles travelling through Harmer Hill using The Hollow and accessing Ellesmere Road, creating a very dangerous situation. Many of the tractors were travelling between the two farms owned by the same family and it was suggested that the Clerk should write to the owners outlining residents' concerns. This has been done and there is an assurance that once the harvest is over, there is unlikely to be many tractors travelling through the Village and in the meantime every effort will be made to improve the safety of all concerned.

Highways Issues

The Clerk reported that all the issues raised at the last meeting had been reported to the Highways Department or to Mr. David Gradwell (Road Safety Officer). Action had been promised but Shropshire Councillor B. Williams pointed out that budget restrictions, increased demand and dealing with the Coronavirus restrictions meant that there was long waiting list for problems to get resolved.

### PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

Loss of access to footpaths

Concerns had been raised about access to the permissive footpaths leading into the woods opposite Harmer Hill Village Hall being prevented by a locked gate, but the problem appeared to have been resolved. There were also complaints at loss of access to fields off Lower Road, but it is understood that these are not public footpaths and that the farmer intends to keep sheep on the fields.

Standing Orders

The Clerk had tabled a new set of orders to take account of the changes needed to deal with issues arising from the coronavirus regulations and after due consideration these were adopted.

Housing

The Vice-Chairman reported that a well- attended meeting had been held, to discuss the possibility of constructing some affordable housing in the Parish under a 106 agreement, which meant that local people were given the first opportunity to rent the properties. It had been agreed to set up an advisory committee and there had been a positive response from Councillors and community members. Mr. Green (Rural Housing Officer) was arranging a Zoom meeting for later in the month.

Planning Applications

A number of applications had been received and were given detailed consideration before positive responses were made to all of them.

Children's Play Areas

The annual RoSPA report had been received and was considered and it was agreed that the Clerk should arrange a meeting with Mr. Ray Parry (Play Area Consultant) to consider the actions that needed to be taken to ensure that all the equipment was safe to use.

At the end of the meeting there was unanimous support from everyone, when the Chairman thanked Councillor Mrs. Hodge for the outstanding work she had carried out in producing, collating and arranging distribution of The Messenger for over twenty years.
