

#### **Cadir Idris from Harmer Hill**

"Cadair Idris is left of centre, at 50 miles away in a straight line. It has a height of 2930 feet with the Welsh Coast only 10 miles further on. The hills to the right are the Arans (Aran Fawddwy, 2971 feet and Aran Benllyn 2904 feet). With all three so close to 3000 feet I guess you could call them mountains. They're all slightly higher than the Berwyns (2730 feet and off this pic to the right), but the Berwyns look higher from Harmer Hill as they're closer, at only 30 miles. In my experience since moving to Harmer Hill just under 2 years ago, Cadair Idris can only be seen about a dozen times each year, whereas the Berwyns are visible a lot more often."





This is the last edition of the Messenger that Danielle will be editing. When the late Liz Hodge had to step down as editor for health reasons we were very lucky to find Danielle as a replacement. As readers may know Danielle has a background in journalism. She walked from Harmer Hill to Myddle during the pandemic for an open-air discussion about the editor's role. It was clear that she was the ideal candidate. Once she took on the role she began to introduce small improvements to make the Messenger a better magazine without offending those

who are less comfortable with change. Last year she introduced colour which has proved popular with readers and, interestingly, another local parish magazine has recently followed her lead. Danielle's move out of the parish clearly made it more difficult for her to continue in the role and she deserves our gratitude for continuing as editor so long after her move. So **THANK YOU DANIELLE** for all you have done in making the Messenger a parish magazine of which we can all be proud.

#### THE FUTURE OF THE MESSENGER ...... UNCERTAIN

We are still looking for a new editor. This is the very last edition that Danielle will be editing. If you think you might be interested and would like to know more about the editor's role please give Danielle a call on 07453-676303. We have put in place temporary arrangements that will allow the magazine to continue for a few more months at least. However, from October we will be publishing the magazine every other month and so the next issue will be an October/November edition and there will be no separate November edition. The long-term future of the magazine remains in doubt if we cannot find a new editor.

#### £11m available to help lift Shropshire homes out of fuel poverty

Shropshire Council has £11 million for its Sustainable Warmth Programme to assist local people to improve their homes and reduce harm caused by fuel poverty. The funding will be used to help retrofit the homes of residents living off-gas. Fully funded works will include insulation, heat pumps, first-time double glazing, and solar panels. Expressions of interest are now being invited from residents and landlords to the Sustainable Warmth Programme. Qualifying residents will receive a free assessment to identify the types of measures that will be most effective for their home. All works will be delivered by accredited and council-approved contractors.

The scheme follows a whole house approach - this means considering fabric measures (i.e. windows, doors, insulation) before changing or improving heating systems. It is not a crisis/emergency scheme. The grant process does take time. Applicants must have lived in their property for a minimum of 6 months and properties must be occupied. The scheme is not intended to support large-scale home renovation projects or refurbishments. Private tenants can apply, but landlords will need to consent to all works and will be expected to make a financial contribution. Social Housing Tenants cannot apply. Landlords that rent out more than four properties do not qualify.

There are three qualification routes:

Route 1 - Households in receipt of means-tested benefits (including Pension Credit Guarantee, Universal Credit, ESA and Child or Working Tax Credits etc) The recipient of the qualifying benefit must be a permanent adult resident of the property.

Route 2 - Households not in receipt of government benefits can still qualify for grants if their gross annual household income is below £31,000 per year.

Route 3 - Flexible eligibility for households in receipt of a council tax rebate (excluding the single person rebates) or with a long-term health condition and or disability that is affected by a cold home or in receipt of free school meals.



# September 2023 – Love in a Box

What must it be like to share a toothbrush, go without soap to afford food, or have nothing to write with or on? That's how it is for families in Eastern Europe living in shacks with no electricity or running water. This is one of the areas where Wrexham-based charity, Teams4U, is working to improve fragile lives. Teams4U was founded by Dave Cooke and last September we were privileged to hear Dave speak movingly of his life helping the marginalised and vulnerable. Dave first took shoe boxes packed with toys and other small gifts for children on a lorry load of Romanian aid 25 years ago, and the idea of Christmas shoe boxes was born.

Christmas is a long way off but it's never too early to think about vulnerable children who have nothing to call their own. Packing a shoe box with simple gifts is a wonderful way to let a child who may never have received a present know they are not forgotten, and someone does care. It's hands-on and personal, sending love and bringing colour into a drab existence. If you would like to transform the life of a vulnerable child by packing a shoe box with small gifts, you can find out more on the charity website www.teams4u .com. There are You tube videos showing boxes being filled with lots of ideas of what to put in (@teams4Utube).

It's amazing how many gifts can fit into a shoe box, each one a special treat for the recipient, things we take for granted but they may never have owned before like: a simple wash kit (soap& flannel, toothbrush & paste), stationery (school set, notebook, pencil case, pens, crayons, colouring book), warm outdoor clothing (hat, scarf, gloves) so they can play in the snow, everyday toys (cuddly toy, ball, doll, cars, animals), a book with few words (where the pictures tell the story), a basic game or puzzle needing no instructions (snap, dominoes, small jigsaw)...

To pack a box the first thing to do is to

find an empty shoe box and cover it with colourful wrapping paper. (If you don't have a box, a flat-pack box can be collected from the Rectory, Myddle.) Next decide whether you'd like to pack a girl or a boy's box and for what age. There are three categories to choose from: 3-5, 6-11 or 12+ years. Age labels can be downloaded to stick on your box lid, or you can use labels found in a printed leaflet collected from church.

There is always a shortage of boxes for teenage boys. It's not too difficult to fill a teenage boy box though; I usually pack wash kit, school supplies, warm hat, gloves & scarf, small soft toy, plus other basic items our teens may think very ordinary such as a tennis ball, yoyo, playing cards, Rubiks cube, travel chess, drawing book, small cars, marbles, badge, bracelet...

If you'd rather send practical household items, you can pack a 'home' box instead to be given to a mother for the home. Useful things like candles, tea towel, dish cloth, wooden spoon, clothes pegs, foldable shopping bag, small toiletries, wind-up torch can be included. When your box is full, add the transport costs (details in the leaflet, or pay online), secure the box lid with an elastic band and bring to the Rectory, Myddle during the **week after half term**. Boxes will be taken to the Teams4U Wrexham warehouse in time for Christmas delivery to those who need them most.

With the cost of living going up, packing a whole box may be too much but just one small gift can be used to help fill a shared box. Any gifts you can spare for these boxes I am packing would be welcome, hopefully **before the end of September** to allow time to include them. I'm particularly grateful to those who are busily knitting warm hats and scarves, or sewing. Please don't stop! If you would like a flat-pack box, or to donate knitting or wool for knitters, or have any other queries, please contact me on 01939 291390 or jothevicarswife@hotmail.com.
