



September 2022 - Pastoral Letter– Love in a Box

During hot weather I was so grateful for cool showers and plenty of cold drinks with ice from the freezer. We take it for granted that water will come when we turn on our tap and that electrical appliances will work to make life easier in extreme temperatures.

It's made me wonder what it's like for those in Eastern Europe who receive the Christmas shoe boxes we pack each autumn. Many of these people have no electricity or personal water supply, queueing to use a communal tap, needing candles on darker days, sharing a bed to keep warm in winter, but they can't turn on a fan when it's hot.

It makes me keener than ever to send lots of shoe boxes packed with simple everyday gifts for children living in such poor conditions. I really hate to think of anyone with no toothbrush or paste and the idea of children having to stay indoors when it snows because they have no warm hat, scarf or gloves is hard to take in. The thought of any child with no soft toy or ball, a girl with no doll or a boy with no toy vehicle so sad.

A shoe box packed with love may be their only gift ever and it's sobering to consider that they may well have no stationery, so notebook, colouring book, pencils, pens and crayons will be treasures. A simple bar of soap and a flannel to wash it off will also be highly valued by someone who cannot shower or have a good soak in a bath.

It also makes me want to send 'home' boxes to be given to mothers struggling to manage their families with no washing line or clothes pegs, hopefully including candles and a wind-up torch for those darker winter months and basic household essentials like a dish cloth and tea towel so they can wash up.

Such ordinary gifts could make an incredible difference to the lives of our European neighbours, and we will be collecting packed boxes here in early November for the Wrexham Teams4u warehouse to deliver in time for Christmas. This year we can hear what it's like to hand out the boxes and the impact the love that went into packing them has on the recipients. Dave Cooke, founder of the Teams4u charity has offered to come and talk to us and show pictures about his many experiences helping the poorest of the poor. He will bring leaflets with details of exactly how to pack a box and special stickers (home box or boy/girl age group 3-5, 6-11 or 12+years) to label them with.

I think Dave's presentation will be memorable so I hope you will join us on <u>Sunday 11th September</u> in <u>Myddle Church</u> at <u>10.30am</u>. Everyone is welcome!

<u>Bomere Heath Community Car Scheme</u> - Bomere Heath operate a community car scheme. Mrs Jenny Edge, the co-ordinator has indicated that they will assist wherever possible with transport in our area. People using the scheme are required to make a contribution per mile for travel. For further details please contact Mrs Jenny Edge. (01939) 290 092

British Red Cross – The British Red Cross can offer support to help individuals avoid hospital admissions. They can also provide assistance prior to hospital discharge or if recently discharged from hospital. You ordinarily will need to be referred by a health professional for discharge assistance but can also contact them yourself once discharged. They can provide temporary assistance for up to 6 weeks from discharge with things such as collecting prescriptions, shopping, regular check & chats, befriending, as well as assistance with obtaining a pendant alarm if you are at risk of falls. They are also excellent at signposting people to other services that might be of help. Telephone (01743) 457 800 for further information.

Shropshire Mind – www.shropshiremhs.com (01743) 368 647

Shropshire Mental Health Support (MHS), support individuals affected by mental and emotional distress through a wide range of quality services. These include offering telephone support, outreach support, a drop-in centre and an opportunity to become actively involved with growing and tending an allotment in Monkmoor. They also run 'Shropshire Sanctuary' that provides person centred listening during evenings and through the night for people experiencing an acute mental health crisis. (Referral Only). Please contact them for further information, Mon-Fri 9am-5pm.

Myddle Support Network — A local voluntary network that was initially created to provide help to people in the Myddle area during the Coronavirus pandemic. One of life's great difficulties is knowing what to do for the best in any of the situations we find ourselves in. Most of us want to be known to be a kind sort of person and many of us will go to great lengths to show kindness to someone in need. We want to be kind to people but when given the choice we prefer to be kind to them in our own way, and should it happen that our way of being kind is not the way that is needed, we get it wrong, easily take offence, think that we are not appreciated and deny the real needs of whoever we want to help.

In the story of Mary and Martha (Luke 10:38-42), Jesus shows us that if we want to be kind to someone, the first necessity is to attempt to look into the heart of the person we desire to help, to see what they really need. Having done this, we should then forget all our own plans and think only of what can be done to meet the needs of

the person we want to help.

Martha was a kind person. She wanted to get things right, but she had a problem. The sort of kindness she wanted to show to an important guest was the wrong type of kindness. Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem where he was going to be put to death.

He knew that this was God's will but he was struggling with the need to be When obedient. Jesus arrived at the home of Mary and Martha, it was a great day and Martha fussed around preparing a great spread, and inviting many quests but that was exactly what Jesus did not want. All he wanted was a quiet, calm place and an hour or two away from the crowds. Mary wanted to give him that, but Martha, in her kindness was doing her best to destroy what Jesus really needed.


