



# Doing what's right

I want to share with you today a story that I discovered recently. I hadn't heard it before and it made an impression on me. In the 1890s, a poor Scottish farmer named Fleming was working in the field when he heard a cry for help coming from a nearby bog. He quickly dropped his tools and ran to the bog. There, mired to his waist in black muck, was a terrified boy, screaming and struggling to free himself. Farmer Fleming saved the lad from what could have been a slow and terrifying death.

The next day, a fancy carriage pulled up to the Scotsman's sparse surroundings. elegantly dressed nobleman stepped out and introduced himself as the father of the boy Farmer Fleming had saved. "I want to repay you," said the nobleman. "You saved my son's life." "I can't accept payment for what I did," the Scottish farmer replied, waving off the offer. "It was the right thing to do." At that moment, the farmer's own son came to the door of the family hovel. "Is that your son?" the nobleman asked. "Yes," the farmer said proudly...

..."I'll make you a deal. Let me provide him with the level of education my own son will enjoy. If the lad is anything like his father, he'll no doubt grow to be a man we will both be proud of." And that he did. Farmer Fleming's son attended the very best schools and in time, graduated from St. Mary's Hospital Medical School in London and went on to become known throughout the world as the noted Sir Alexander Fleming, the discoverer of penicillin.

Years later, the same nobleman's son who was saved from the bog was stricken with pneumonia. What saved his life this time? Penicillin. And I am sure that there are people in the Parish today whose illness has been cured or even their lives have been saved by the drug penicillin So what was the name of the nobleman? Lord Randolph Churchill. And his son's name? Sir Winston Churchill.

There is, of course, a moral to the story. Farmer Fleming did the right thing, not because of any anticipated reward, but because the right thing is the right thing to do...

...He could never have foreseen the amazing results that would come years later from that one choice and action. Only God knew. #### Parish Council Election

Following the decision by six existing Members not to stand for re-election only eight residents sought election for the available ten seats. This meant that there were two vacancies which the Council could fill by 'adopting' members who would have the rights as elected same Members. Following some applications publicity, two were received and both people were co-opted at the meeting meaning that there is now a full Council.

# Council Meeting - May 13th

Changes to the regulations governing Council meetings meant that this month's meeting could not be held online using Zoom, so for the first time in twelve months the meeting was held in the Myddle Village Hall under strict Covid distancing rules.

This meant that it was not possible to allow members of the public to attend and raise issues without an appointment and the same regulations will apply to the meeting in June, which will be held in Harmer Hill Village Hall...

...As this was the Annual General Meeting of the Council the first business was the election of officers and representatives.

Councillor Colin Ruck was re-elected un-apposed Chairman with Councillor Ian Anderson appointed as Vice Chairman also un-apposed. Councillors then took on responsibility board for various attendance at committees and details of these can be found in the draft minutes which are already posted on the Council's web site.

#### Wem Road Pavement

This pavement had been included in the plans for the housing development that had taken place on Wem Road but had not been constructed by the developer. The Parish Council had put pressure on the planners and the developer to have the work completed but no action had been taken. Shropshire Councillor B. Williams had been giving support for the past eighteen months and confirmed that the issue was now going to be subject to an enforcement order.
